Welcome

Welcome to Ultimate Dance Company!

We are excited to have your dancer join us for the 2026–2027 season. Our programs are designed to provide high-quality training in a positive and supportive environment.

At UDC, we are committed to supporting each dancer's growth in confidence, discipline, and skill, while creating an encouraging and professional studio experience.

Program Overview

Ultimate Dance Company offers recreational programs for dancers ages 3 and up across a variety of styles, including:

- Ballet
- Jazz
- Tap
- Hip Hop
- Breakdance
- Acro
- Contemporary & Lyrical (ages 11+)

Class Structure

- Recreational classes (ages 5+) are 45 minutes
- Preschool Combo classes are 45 minutes
- Preschool Acro classes are 30 minutes
- Classes run from September through June and follow a full-season structure



What's new for 2026–2027

Preschool Acro

New for the 2026–2027 season, our Preschool Acro program offers a specialized introduction to acrobatic training in a small class setting.

Enrollment is limited to maintain a low student-to-teacher ratio and ensure quality instruction.

Level I & II (Acro & Hip Hop)

New for the 2026–2027 season, Level I and Level II classes will be introduced in both Acro and Hip Hop.

These classes are intended for dancers ages 11+ who have completed a minimum of one year of training in Acro or Hip Hop. Placement may be subject to instructor recommendation.

Program Fees

Preschool (Ages 3–4)

- Combo Class (Ballet, Tap, Jazz) (45 min) – \$78/month
- Preschool Acro (30 min) – \$72/month

Ages 5+

All classes are 45 minutes in length

- Recreational Classes – \$82/month (Ballet, Jazz, Tap, Hip Hop, Breakdance, Contemporary, Lyrical)
- Recreational Acro – \$84/month

Multi-Class Discounts

- 2–3 classes – 5%
- 4+ classes – 10%

All fees are subject to GST.



Registration & Payments

- A \$50 registration fee per dancer is due at the time of registration
- June 2027 tuition is due at registration and is non-refundable once processed. No exceptions.
- Monthly tuition is processed on the 1st (September–May)
- Tuition is structured over a 10-month dance season (September–June), with consistent monthly payments
- A \$40 fee will apply to any declined or returned payments
- Payment methods: Visa, Mastercard, Visa Debit

Enrollment & Cancellations

- Once classes have commenced, one month written notice is required to cancel enrollment in any recreational program. Registration fees and June tuition are non-refundable once processed. No exceptions
- A \$50.00 + GST administration fee will be applied to process cancellations
- Cancellations are accepted until January 31 of the dance season
- After this date, all remaining tuition fees through June are the responsibility of the family. No exceptions
- Enrollment in a program is intended as a commitment to the full dance season
- Class changes may be accommodated based on availability and require approval through the office



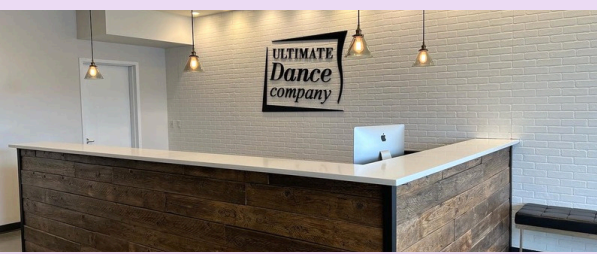
Recital Information

All dancers participate in our year-end recital, **“Showcase of Stars,”** held at the end of the season. This is a special opportunity for dancers to perform on stage and celebrate their progress throughout the year.

- Participation in the recital is a part of the program
- Recreational costume fees are processed on February 1
- Additional recital details, including schedules and ticket information, will be shared with families throughout the season

Studio Policies

- Please notify the studio if your dancer will be absent
- Classes build on skills each week, so consistent attendance is important
- Make-up classes are not offered and refunds are not issued for missed classes
- Class schedules may be adjusted as needed throughout the season. Any updates will be communicated to families
- Classes may be combined or cancelled due to enrollment
- In the event of severe weather, an email will be sent if classes are cancelled
- While we make every effort to run classes as scheduled, please use your discretion when travel conditions are unsafe in your area
- Missed classes due to weather will not be rescheduled
- If an instructor is unavailable, a qualified substitute teacher will be in class to ensure classes continue as scheduled



Communication

- Email is the primary method of communication at Ultimate Dance Company
- Monthly newsletters are sent at the beginning of each month with important studio updates
- Families are responsible for ensuring all contact information is current

Studio Etiquette

- Outdoor shoes must be removed upon entering the studio
- No food, gum, or beverages (other than water) are permitted in the studio spaces
- Dancers are expected to arrive on time and be picked up promptly after class
- All dancers must follow the studio dress code
- Respect for teachers, staff, and fellow dancers is expected at all times
- Disruptive behaviour or inappropriate language is not permitted
- Cell phones are not permitted inside the classrooms
- The lobby is a shared space; children must be supervised by a parent or guardian when not in class



Studio Attire

- All dancers are required to follow the Ultimate Dance Company studio dress code

- Proper attire supports safe training, correct technique, and a professional classroom environment

Participation Agreement

All families are required to review and accept the Participation Agreement and Waiver as part of the registration process for the 2026–2027 season

Getting Started

- A \$50 registration fee and June 2027 tuition are processed at the time of enrollment to secure your dancer's placement, these fees are non-refundable. No exceptions
- The Participation Agreement and Waiver are completed as part of the registration process
- Current UDC families will receive access to priority registration each season, prior to general registration



Frequently Asked Questions

What happens if my dancer misses a class?

Classes build on skills each week, so consistent attendance is important. Make-up classes are not offered and refunds are not issued for missed classes.

Can my dancer switch classes?

Class changes may be accommodated based on availability and require approval through the office.

Are costumes included in tuition?

Costumes and recital-related fees are not included in tuition and are billed separately.

Is the year-end recital mandatory?

All dancers participate in our year-end recital, "Showcase of Stars," as part of the program.

What should my dancer wear to class?

All dancers are required to follow the studio dress code. Please refer to our website for full attire guidelines.

How do I know which class is right for my dancer?

Our team is happy to help with class placement. Please contact the studio if you are unsure which program is the best fit.

How will I receive updates throughout the season?

All studio communication is sent via email, including monthly newsletters and important updates.
